The program will first open to senior managers who are credentialed and candidates for credentialing.
If the program is not full as of May 15, 2017 it will open to non-credentialed managers who are members of ICMA.

Application Deadline: ICMA will begin accepting applications on January 23, 2017. Successful candidates will be notified and confirmed as soon as payment is received. Payment in full for tuition is due at time of application. *\$250 of your fee is non-refundable through July 15th. After July 15th the full program fee is non-refundable.*

Registration fee includes all interpretive fees and materials, breakfast, lunch and dinner on Monday; breakfast and dinner on Tuesday. And a Colonial Williamsburg pass for the event. Applicants will be admitted to the program on a rolling basis. Credentialed Managers and Candidates may apply anytime. ICMA members who are not credentialed may apply starting May 15, 2017 if space is available.

Lodging: Lodging is \$189/night (not including taxes). ICMA will help you arrange your reservation at the Brickhouse Tavern, an Inn on the property of Colonial Williamsburg. Attendees are responsible for payment of their lodging expenses. Should the Brickhouse fill up, arrangements will be made at another Williamsburg property (nightly fee may vary).

Overview: In November of 2013, 2014 and 2015, the Williamsburg Leadership Institute took place in the Revolutionary City. ICMA colleagues became a citizen of Colonial Williamsburg and engaged for three days in a highly interactive leadership study that contrasts the core values of the founding fathers (who maintained continuity of purpose during times of civil unrest and social upheaval) with today's turbulent times.

Leadership lessons begin as you talk with fellow citizen Thomas Jefferson, and continue with first-hand experiences, including time in George Wythe's classroom of the political and cultural unrest as our nation was formed.

Required reading: A reading list will be provided upon acceptance.

Institute Schedule: November 5, 2017 to November 8, 2017 (3 pm start on Sunday) program concludes the evening of Tuesday, November 7 with optional Wednesday activities such as a visit to Jamestown, VA and further exploration of Colonial Williamsburg.
