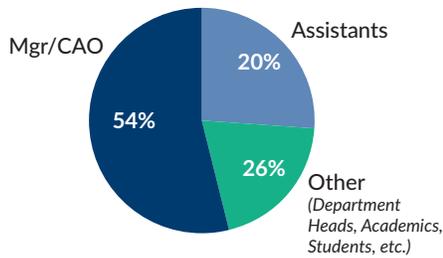

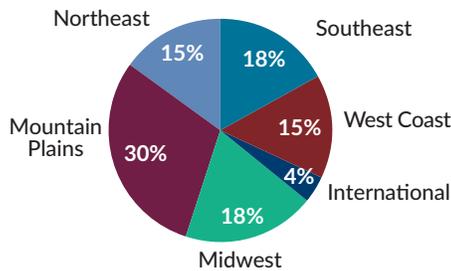

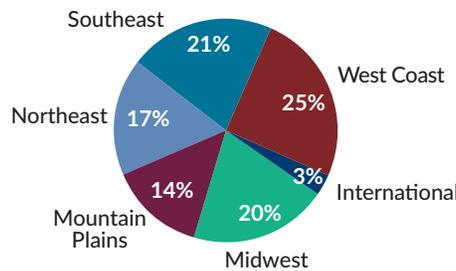
2018 ATTENDANCE BY TITLE
