



## **Williamsburg Leadership Institute**

**Credentialed Managers Receive Priority Acceptance Until July 1, 2019**

**Application Deadline:** ICMA will begin accepting applications on May 1, 2019. Successful candidates will be notified and confirmed as soon as payment is received. Payment in full for tuition is due at time of application. ***\$250 of your fee is non-refundable through July 30th. After July 30th the full program fee is non-refundable.***

Registration fee includes all interpretive fees and materials, breakfast, lunch and dinner on Monday; breakfast and dinner on Tuesday. And a Colonial Williamsburg pass for the event. Applicants will be admitted to the program on a rolling basis. Credentialed Managers and Candidates will receive priority acceptance if applying prior to July 1, 2019.

**Lodging:** Lodging is \$189/night (not including taxes). ICMA will help you arrange your reservation at the Brickhouse Tavern, an Inn on the property of Colonial Williamsburg. Attendees are responsible for payment of their lodging expenses. Should the Brickhouse fill up, arrangements will be made at another Williamsburg property (nightly fee may vary).

**Overview:** The Williamsburg Leadership Institute takes place in the Revolutionary City. ICMA colleagues become citizens of Colonial Williamsburg and engaged for three days in a highly interactive leadership study that contrasts the core values of the founding fathers, who maintained continuity of purpose during times of civil unrest and social upheaval, with today's turbulent times.

Leadership lessons begin as you talk with fellow citizens and notable historical figures, learning of the political and cultural unrest as our nation was formed from first-hand experiences, including time in George Wythe's classroom.

**Institute Schedule** The program begins at 3 pm ET on Sunday November 3, 2019 and concludes the evening of Tuesday, November 5, 2019 at 7:30pm. On November 6, you can take advantage of your Colonial Williamsburg pass and further explore Colonial Williamsburg on your own, or plan a visit to Jamestown, VA.
