




EMO SPECIAL ASSISTANTS (EMO SA) PROGRAM





WHAT IS THE EMO SA PROGRAM?







SUPPORT PROVIDED BY GRANT

- Salary and relocation
- Attendance at annual convenings
- Local collaboration efforts (e.g. co-design, interns, other activities)
- Professional development
- Coaching, technical assistance, and consulting





IDEAL HOST COMMUNITY

- Local government with a holistic understanding of community conditions that influence economic mobility for residents and motivation to act:
 - workforce development
 - housing affordability
 - household financial security
 - other EMO topics
- Local government with a supportive and collaborative organizational culture
- Medium-sized local government
- Vision of longer-term support and sustainability of EMO efforts





TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

- U.S. local government entities must include one ICMA member serving in a senior role
- Host communities must be able to support their special assistant with a typical full-time employee benefits package
- EMO SA must report directly to CAO or other executive leadership
- Supportive of co-design process launched within 6 months
- Participation in all virtual and in person meetings from EMO SAs and other reps





CONTRACT PROCESS

- Expect that this process will require a quick turnaround time to ensure proper participation
- Upon selection, local governments will be required to complete the ICMA subgrant agreement process
- Grant funds will be disbursed in multiple payments
 - First payment anticipated within 1-2 months of selection to cover approximately 6 months of salary, initial activities and travel
 - Subsequent payments are anticipated to be paid annually





APPLICATION CONTENT & SELECTION

- Understanding of community EMO needs
- Demonstrated commitment to upward mobility and opportunity for residents
- Organizational challenges and capacity to advance EMO strategies
- Demonstrated commitment to cross-sector partnerships
- Descriptions of:
 - How position engages directly with executive leadership
 - New position or re-working a position
 - Proposed compensation, benefits
- Geographic, economic, and demographic diversity in host communities



ANTICIPATED TIMELINE

- May 30, 2025 (5:00 pm PT): Application closes
- Mid-June 2025: Selected local governments notified (subject to change)

Once a local government is selected...

- Summer 2025: Submit required vendor documents, sign subgrant agreement with ICMA, orientation, draft job description, publicize position and start hiring process
- Fall 2025: Special Assistants hired by host communities
- Q4 2025: In-person EMO SA + LG leaders meeting, location TBD (subject to change)
