- Fill the cart only when the cart is in a stable and upright position
- Rinse out the cart periodically with water
- Follow the instructions for collection day, place the cart as close as possible to the curb, and retrieve the cart when empty
- Call your SPSA Recycling Department at 548-2256 if your cart is broken or you have any questions about using the cart

No, Don't

- Tilt or move the cart with the lid open
- Overfill the cart Make sure the weight limit is not exceeded and the lid will close completely before moving the cart
- Step or climb on the wheels
- Sit or stand on top of the cart or climb in the cart body
- Drag the cart
- Use the cart if it is broken Call for a repair
- Let children or pets play around the cart
- Put hot coals, ashes or flammable liquids in the cart
- Put hazardous waste, paints, oil, corrosives, or dead animals in the cart
- Store cart near a heat source, corrosives, or flammable liquids
