Deposit

A deposit of one night's stay in the form of a valid credit card guarantee is required with each reservation.

Room Rates/Taxes

Reservations must be made by September 17, 2010, to take advantage of special rooms rates. Higher rates may exist after that time. All rates are per room and are subject to 14% occupancy tax (12% at hotels near airport). Reservations may be changed (based on availability) or cancelled until September 17, 2010 without penalty. A \$25 processing fee will be assessed on cancellations after September 17, 2010.

- Special requests are not guaranteed. Hotels will assign specific room types upon check-in, based on availability.
- Rates include a rebate to cover housing and other conference costs.

Acknowledgments

The Housing Connection will send reservation acknowledgements within 24 hours via email if booked online or by telephone; fax and mail acknowledgements will be sent within 72 hours of receipt. If you do not receive your acknowledgement in this time frame, contact The Housing Connection. You will not receive a written confirmation from the hotel.

Cancellations/Changes/Refunds

- Cancellations after September 17, 2010, and prior to 72 hours before arrival date will be subject to a \$25 processing fee. One night's room and tax will be forfeited if cancellation occurs within 72 hours of arrival.

- Do not contact the hotels directly until after October 6, 2010.


