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
Becoming too focused

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Assistance for Citizens

Individual Assistance:

- •When the president approves a federal disaster declaration for IA, the Individual Assistance and Households Program (IHP) is available.
- •Under IHP, two main categories of assistance are available to citizens: Housing Assistance and Other Needs.
- •Housing Assistance is 100% federal
- •DUA may be available for those who lose jobs because of disaster

Public Assistance

Designed to assist local governments with infrastructure and response



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Public Assistance (PA)



The objective of the Public Assistance (PA) program is to provide assistance to state, tribal, and local governments, and certain types of private nonprofit organizations

Public Assistance

Reimburse for costs that have already occurred

Good records management system is critical BEFORE the crisis



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Public Assistance (PA) cont'd

- Reimburse local and state governments for expenses involved in response and recovery operations
- Provide assistance in repairing public infrastructure



Assisting the Individual

Does not make the individual whole; meets the day to day need



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Individual Assistance

- When the President approves a federal disaster declaration for Individual Assistance, the declaration activates the Individual Assistance and Households Program (IHP)
- Under IHP, two main categories of assistance are available to private citizens – Housing Assistance and Other Needs Assistance

With states lacking funds – who will match?



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Individual Assistance cont'd

This form of disaster assistance is provided on a cost share basis — 75% federal, 25% non-federal state
