

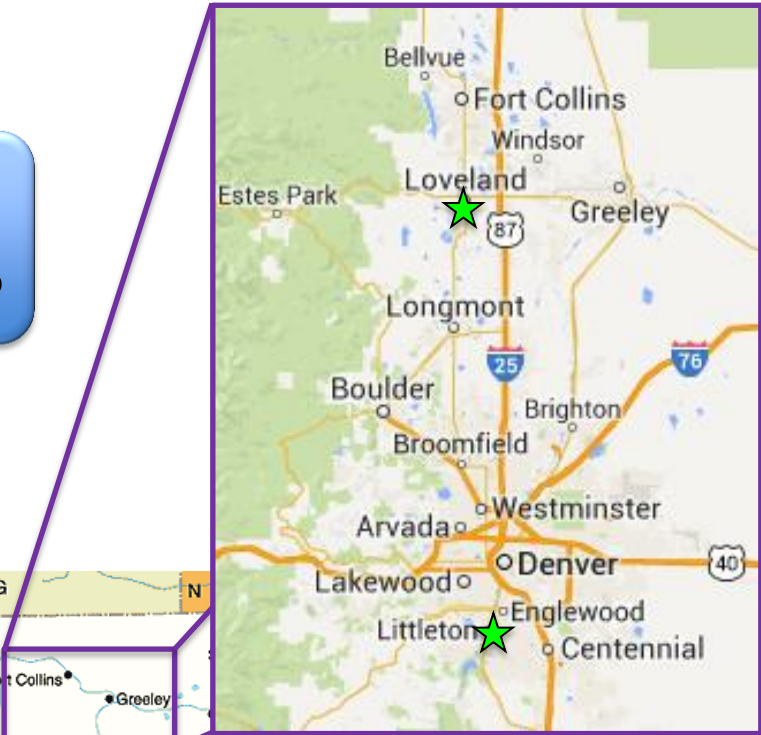

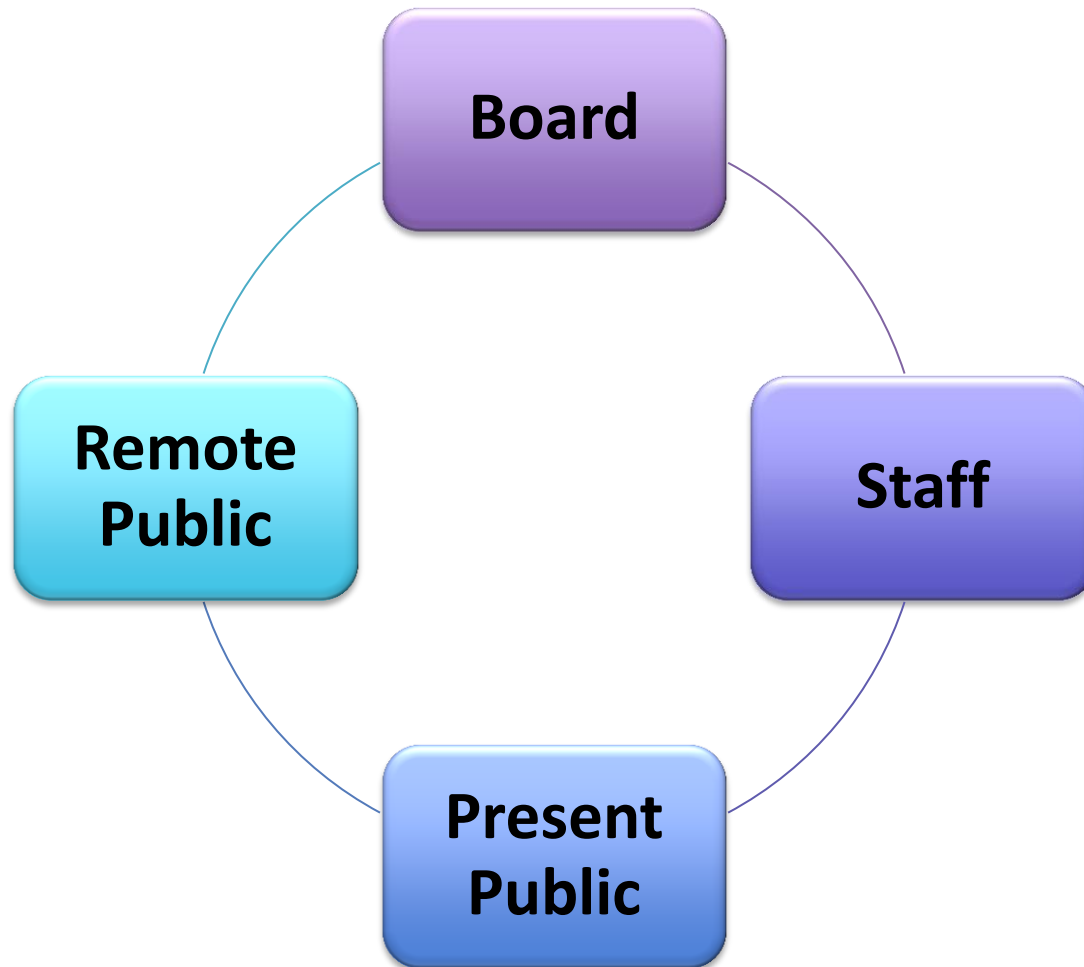


For the body to make open and public decisions

# Quality Participation by the Body

All participants have access to the same information

Written  
Material

All participants can contribute on a  
roughly equal basis

Disparities in information and participation lead to  
sub-par results

All participants can receive  
the same information



All participants can observe the  
actions of the body



All participants can effectively communicate to all  
members of the body

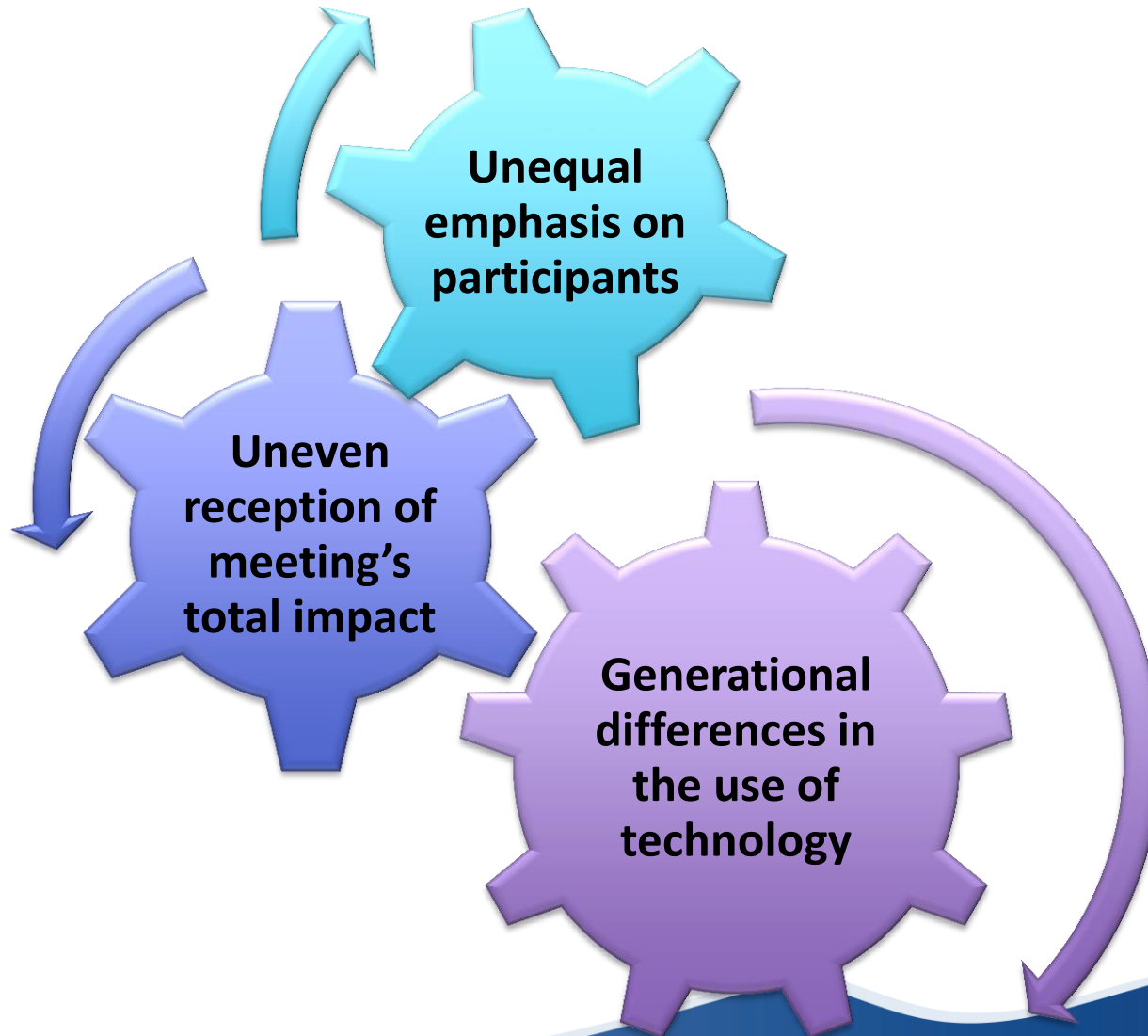
## Medium Filters:
