I'm delighted to provide you all with an update about our CityLinks activities. Currently, program staff is gearing up for year four activities and will release the annual report for year three in the coming weeks.

The [Georgia Waste Management Project](#) is off to a running start. During the quarter, the project held a recyclable waste craft contest for students in grades 9 through 12 and hosted an eco-summer camp designed around the theme of integrated waste management.

In July, the CityLinks team spent a week in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, with a delegation of four local government practitioners from Legazpi, Philippines. The trip was part of the [ASEAN Cities Climate Change Partnership](#) with the goal of sharing promising practices in urban climate adaptation and resilience.

In August, CityLinks executed the second exchange trip of the [Durban-Dar es Salaam Climate Change Partnership](#). Nineteen officials from Kinondoni Municipality visited Durban for a hands on learning experience about coastal erosion and sea level rise. The trip provided visiting officials with an in depth look at the climate change adaptation responses being implemented by eThekweni Municipality, the local government of Durban.
