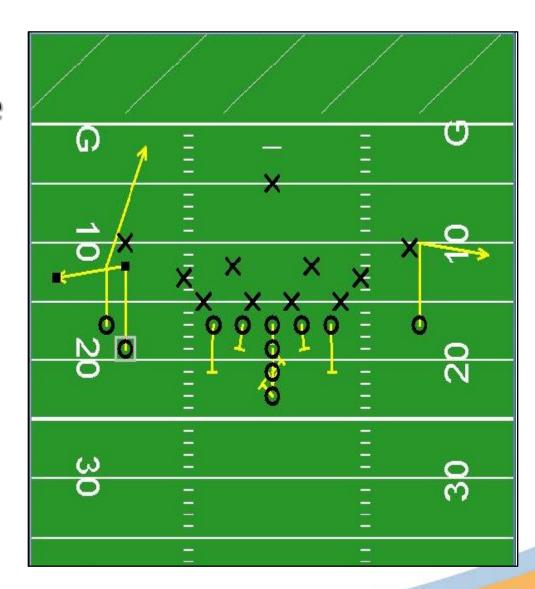


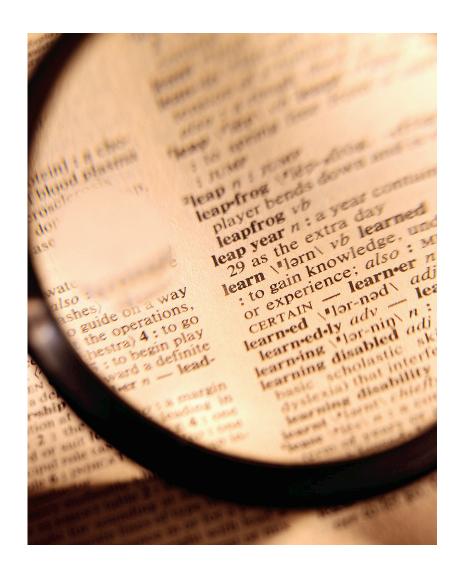


1. Doing More of the Same Doesn't Make a Difference.
