# **Citizen Leadership Academies**

- Civic education programs provided by local government
- Emerging local government practice since 1990's
- Growing focus on citizen training and education
- Focus on building *skills* and *knowledge*

# Similar Local Leadership Programs

#### • Citizen Police Academies

- 45% of all police departments
- Focus on police operations and civic knowledge
- Create positive citizen/police interactions
- Build trust/cooperation
- Minimal participant cost
- Open to all residents

Community Leadership

- Thousands of local communities
- Chamber/United Way
- Broad range of topics and leadership skills
- Build trust, collaboration, involvement
- Higher participant cost
- Highly selective



# **Citizen Leaders Academy Snapshot**

- 2012 survey of 74 municipal programs
- Provided in-house by single government
- Annual program
- Average of 8 sessions for 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>-3 hours
- 20-25 participants
- Minimal participant cost
- \$2000 +/- annual cost (not incl. staff costs)
- Hands on learning and field trips



# **Typical Program Agenda**

- Week 1: Introduction
- Week 2: Community Planning
- Week 3: Development Process
- Week 4: Budget and Finance
- Week 5: Public Works
- Week 6: Utilities
- Week 7: Public Safety
- Week 8: Graduation



#### **Three Broad Goals**

Theme	Basic	Advanced
Knowledge	• Equip citizens with basic information	<ul> <li>Help staff learn citizen perspectives</li> <li>Help citizens learn key issues</li> </ul>
Involvement	<ul> <li>Encourage more involvement</li> <li>Show citizens how to get involved</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Explicitly prepare participants for boards</li> <li>Cultivate community leadership</li> </ul>
Community Relations	<ul> <li>Build communication lines with officials</li> <li>Act as informal ambassadors</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Engage in dialogue</li> <li>Community building w/others and staff</li> </ul>



# **Montgomery Citizens' Academy**

- Example of enhanced capacity building academy
- Started in 2008
- "Coolest civics class you will ever take!"
- 10 sessions, Saturday morning, Jan-Mar
- 25 participants, \$99 fee for materials
- Focus on two way dialogue
- Actively recruit beyond "usual suspects"

- Zen and the Art of Citizenships
- Sycamore Community Schools and the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learner
- Dreams, Aspirations and Taxes...Is the Price Right?
- Homeland Safety and Security in Your Own Backyard
- Service and Volunteerism: A New Call to Action



# **Next Wave of Citizen Training?**

- Relational public problem solving
- Public Achievement: youth civic education model
- Congregational based community organizing
- Clear Vision Eau Claire civic capacity building

# **Relational Public Problem Solving**

- Diverse, small group focus
- Addressing 'wicked problems' through engagement and collaboration
- Identify mutual self-interests
- Build connections to achieve outcomes

# **Core Skills**

- Values house meetings
- One on one relational meetings
- Power mapping community stakeholders
- Action planning
- Public evaluation

### **Examples**

- Dayton Northland Nonprofit Mall Project
- UW-Eau Claire Foundation facilities planning
- Clear Vision Eau Claire
  - P3 downtown performing arts center
  - Homeless shelter
  - Community gardens
  - Summer backpack meals for LMI youth
  - Eau Claire County fairgrounds facility planning



# **Citizen Academies 2.0**

- 21<sup>st</sup> century citizen engagement is not government centric
- Building knowledge and skills
- Empowering citizens for independent community building
- Integrating relational problem solving skills into citizen academy curriculum
