ON 11-12 MAY 2016, THE STRONG CITIES NETWORK (SCN) HELD ITS INAUGURAL GLOBAL SUMMIT IN ANTALYA, TURKEY. THEMES FROM THE SUMMIT



THE NEED FOR LONG-TERM STRATEGIC VISION AND STRONG ACTION PLANS TO COUNTER VIOLENT EXTREMISM. GOVERNOR JOHO ANNOUNCED THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COUNTERING VIOLENT EXTREMISM UNIT WITHIN THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR.

THE NEED TO WORK CLOSELY WITH COMMUNITY ORGANISATIONS, IN PARTICULAR LOCAL RELIGIOUS GROUPS. MAYOR BONTE AND MAYOR BERKE BOTH TALKED ABOUT THE CLOSE TIES THEY HAVE BUILT WITH LOCAL RELIGIOUS AUTHORITIES.



THE NEED TO COORDINATE CVE INITIATIVES WITH PROGRAMMING WHICH ADDRESSES THE ROOT CAUSES OF SOCIAL TENSIONS, INCLUDING SOCIO-ECONOMIC FACTORS. MINISTER PATIL AND LORD MAYOR JENSEN ANNOUNCED THE COORDINATION OF EFFORTS ACROSS SECTORS TO STRENGTHEN CAPACITY IN THEIR RESPECTIVE CITIES TO ENSURE HELP IS PROVIDED TO AT-RISK INDIVIDUALS AND MUNICIPALITIES STAND READY TO RESPOND TO AN ARRAY OF NEEDS.
