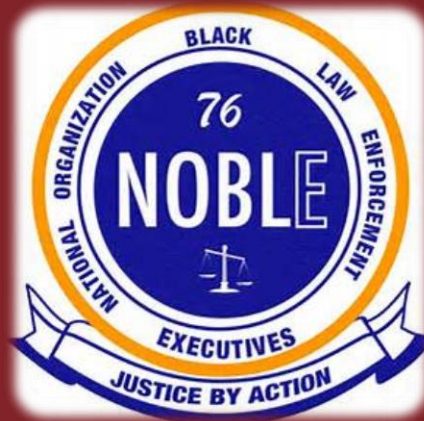

# Building Trust and Legitimacy

- **Address the underline tension**
  - People support and will obey the law if they believe people are acting procedurally just
  
- **Build trust early and use a pragmatic approach**
  - It is too late to build trust if you have an active riot...this must be done before issues and with sincerity...be genuine
  - Temperament...Humility...
  - Compassion-Respect



# Building Trust and Legitimacy

- Change the culture of policing →

Guardians versus warriors

- Embrace community policing →

Work with communities to tackle the immediate and longer-term causes of crime through joint problem solving

- Ensure fair and impartial policing →

Treating people with dignity and respect-  
Convey trust worthy motives

- Build community capital →

Positive and frequency of interactions based on more than just enforcement interactions
