APPLICATION PROCESS

- The Westminster business owner, employee or entrepreneur determines what types of training will benefit their business operations.
- The participant completes this application and returns it prior to the course start date to:

City of Westminster Economic Development Division 4800 W 92nd Avenue Westminster, CO 80031

- City Staff reviews the application and approves or denies the request. Approval is based on availability of program funds and the course's contribution to the businesses' operations.
- If approved, the business owner or employee registers and pays for the course tuition and required materials.
- After successful completion of the course, the business submits proof of satisfactory completion (certificate, letter of completion, etc.) and proof of payment (receipt, credit card statement, returned check, etc.) for the course to the City's Economic Development Division.
- The business receives up to 50% reimbursement for the course, up to \$500 per calendar year.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Small Business Scholarship Program offers reimbursement to Westminster entrepreneurs, licensed small business owners, and their employees for business training. Program participants are reimbursed up to 50% of the cost of tuition, fees, and required materials, up to \$500 per business per calendar year, after successful completion of the course.

Entrepreneurs must have proof of City residence and be participating in entrepreneurial training/small business development courses, with the intent of beginning a small business in Westminster.
