





Challenge: Improve Budgeting Process

- Determining Capital Project priorities and funding
- Involving directors into budgeting process without spreadsheets
- Have access to real-time budget data



Budgeting in Spreadsheets

- Time intensive
- Error-prone
- Difficult to track changes
- Hard for department heads to use



Technical Difficulties

- Previously, no budgeting system
- Data in ERP difficult-to-use
- Spreadsheets are error-prone
- Siloed department information



We cut our time spent budgeting in half.




Approach: Centralize Budgeting in the Cloud


- Collaborative budgeting online

- Will clone budgets for future cycles






