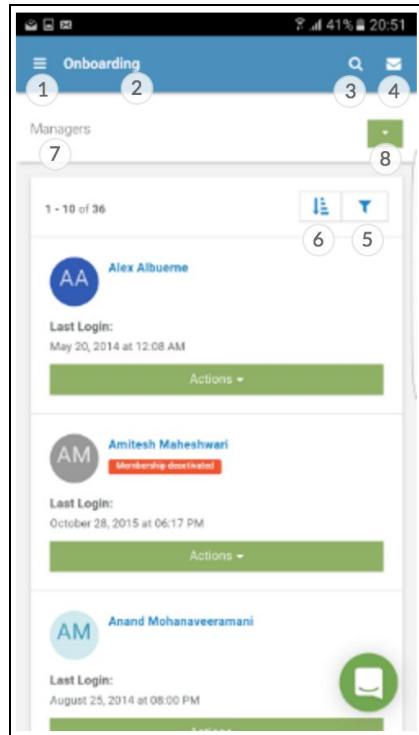
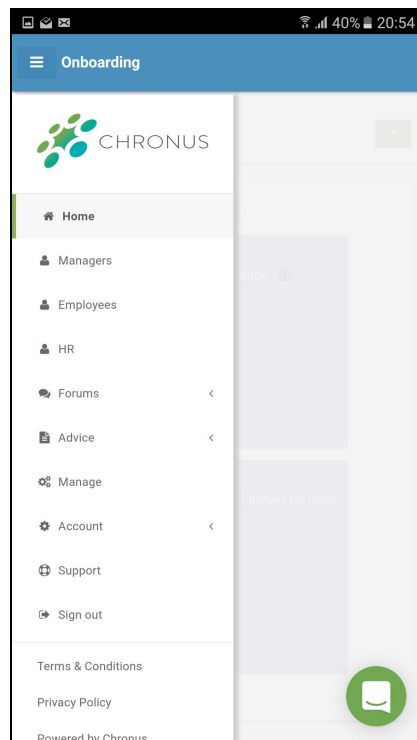
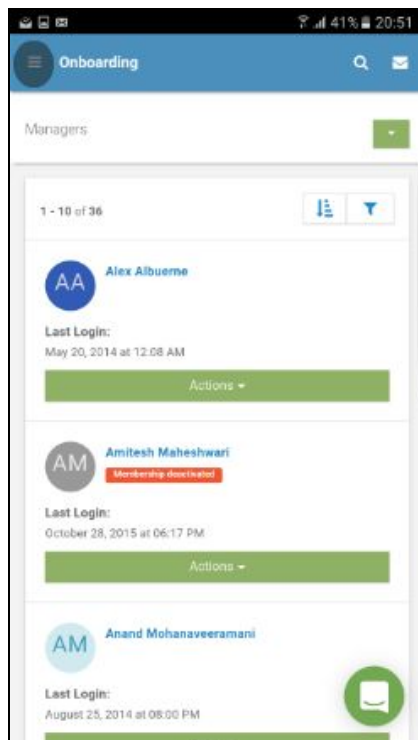


1. Find below the map for the key interaction touch points for accessing a program on a mobile device.

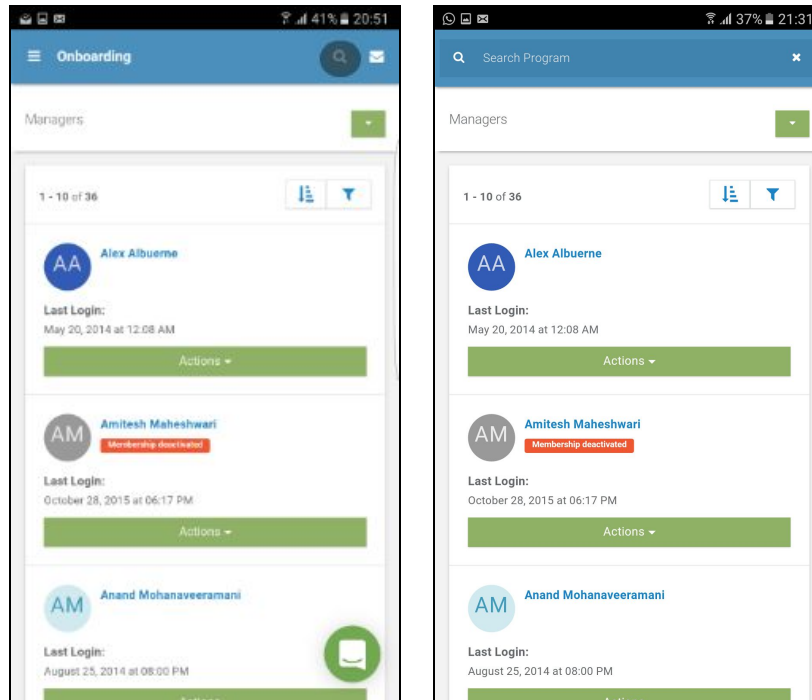

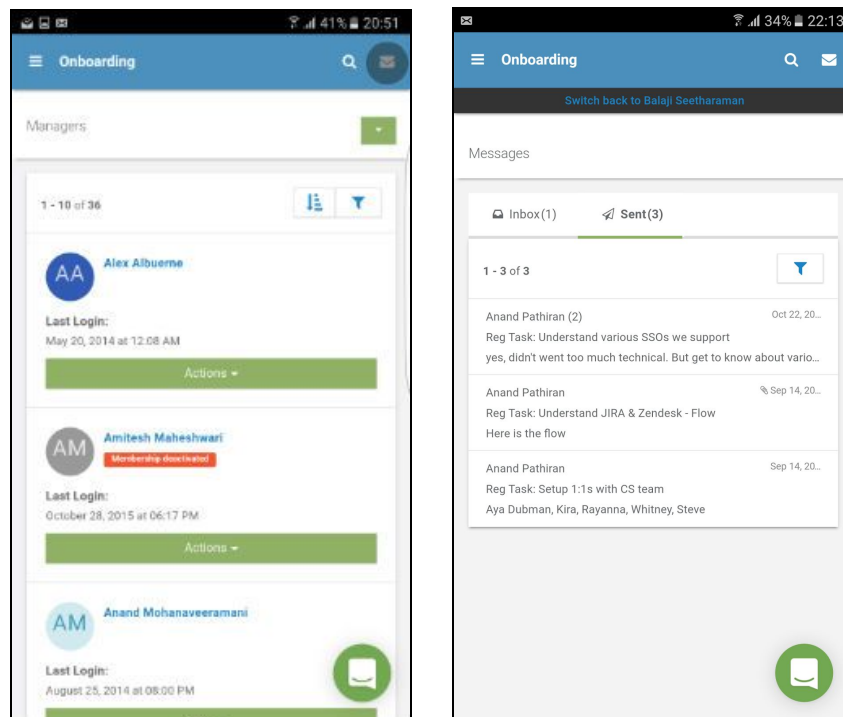

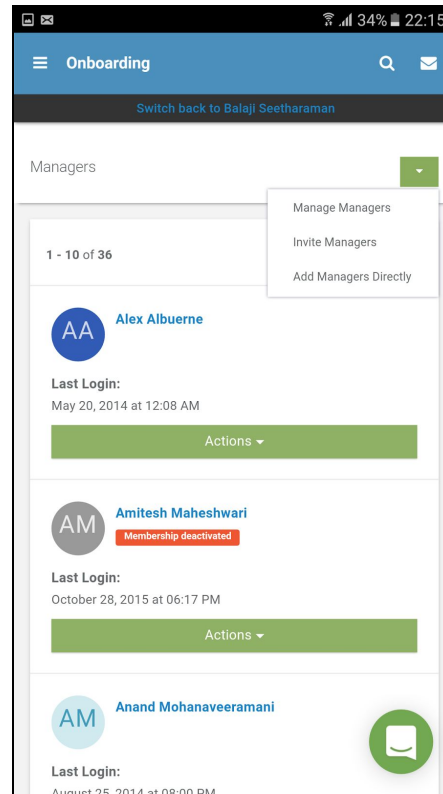
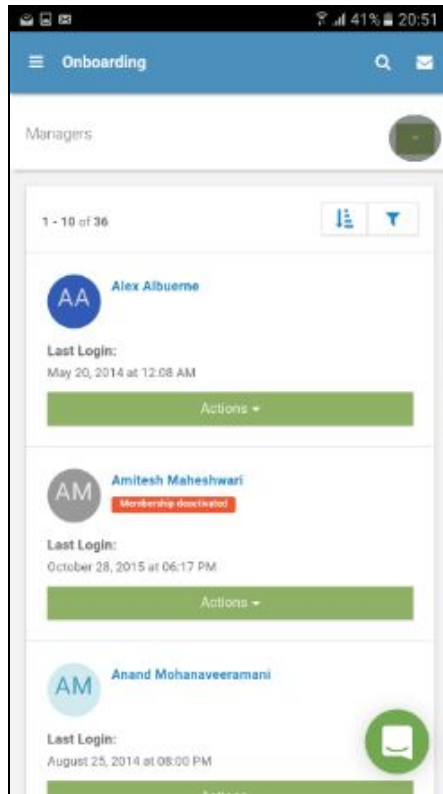

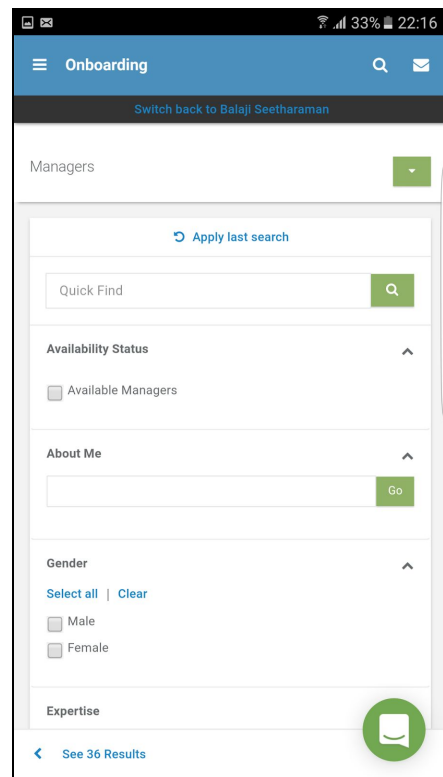
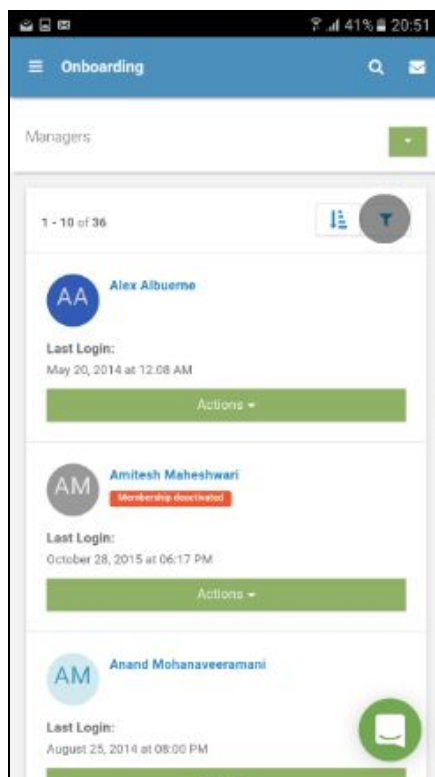
4. The inbox icon (highlighted in the image) is available on the top right side of the header indicated by the envelope icon. Clicking on the inbox icon will open the messages page.
