

ELIGIBLE STATES AND COUNTRIES BY REGION FOR 2021 GEOGRAPHICAL AND POSITION-TYPE ROTATION SUMMARY CHART

Important: The following summary chart pertains to the **2021 election year only**. The Geographical Protocols were written to support the rotation of state/country and position-type representation on the board and are customized and adopted by the leadership in each region. **The rotation of states and position-types change each year and requirements can differ by region.** Candidates and Regional Nominating Committee members are encouraged to view the full details on the Geographical Protocols which can be found in each of the six region’s [Regional Nominating Agreements](#).

Generally, the Regional Nominating Agreements provide that no state or country may succeed itself on the board (there should be a minimum one-year gap for any state or country’s representation on the board), *unless* there is no other qualified candidate. Furthermore, the nominations process will *generally* give preference to states or countries that have not been recently represented on the board *unless* there is no other qualified candidate. Exceptions: Seats dedicated to Canada, Texas, and California. Affiliate members that are also Corporate members may only run for a position in their region’s designated non-CEO year.
