PLASTIC BOTTLES & JUGS

All plastic containers have an identification code stamped on the bottom. Different types of plastic are identified by the number inside the "recycling arrow". In Joplin, #1 and #2 type plastic bottles, soft drinks, clear or colored (except brown), can be recycled. **Remove lids, rinse and Refill.** Containers that hold toxins (pesticides, automotive fluids, etc.) will not be accepted.
